
Overnight water shut-off along Mowat Avenue, Jefferson Avenue and Atlantic Avenue

Expected start date: March 4, 2025 **Duration:** Through March 7, 2025

Hours of work: Overnight, from 7:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.**Timelines may require minor adjustment.

What is happening?

- To facilitate ongoing construction of the new Ontario Line subway station at Exhibition Station, crews must install new watermains within and around the existing site.
- To complete this work, temporary water shutdowns are required overnight, affecting businesses along southern end of the following streets, addresses and dates:

**Water will be reinstated daily by 5:30 a.m.

- Efforts are being made to limit required shutdowns, including scheduling overnight shutoffs to reduce disruption on businesses in Liberty Village.
- Intermittent closures of sidewalks and lanes to be expected while crews are working overnight. Work areas will be stanchioned from pedestrians and traffic, overnight.
- A temporary barrier will separate the work area from pedestrians and traffic and remain in place overnight.
- Crews will access the watermains in proximity to existing fire hydrants, and repair roadways once complete.
- Driveway access will not be impeded or blocked.
- Work may be postponed, extended or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Residents may hear general construction noise during work periods.

What to expect

- Temporary shutdown of water services on the south end of the streets highlighted in red on the map, may be required while water services are transferred.
- Water shutdowns will be completed during overnight shifts (7:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.) to limit impacts to neighboring buildings and tenants. Both fire and domestic water lines will be impacted by this work. Toronto Fire is aware of these temporary outage and have contingency plans in place in the event of emergency.
- Sidewalks and lanes will be impacted intermittently while crews are working in the hydrant area.
